

## DATA PRIVACY PROTECTION

### §1 Information about the collection of personal data

Dr. Klaus Schulte GmbH stores and uses exclusively company-related data (company name, company address, company e-mail, company telephone) of the interested party/buyer for the initiation or processing of a business contractual relationship.

- (1) When contacting us by e-mail or via the contact form on our website, the company-specific data provided by the interested party (company e-mail address, name and company telephone number) is stored by us in order to answer questions. We delete the data arising in this context after the storage is no longer necessary, or limit the processing if statutory retention obligations exist.
- (2) The processing of this data is necessary for the execution of a contract. If the information is not provided, the contract cannot be executed. Within the scope of contract fulfilment, it may be necessary for the seller to pass on the buyer's personal data, order data and customer data to third parties.
- (3) Insofar as Dr. Klaus Schulte GmbH, as the seller of personal data, obtains the consent of the data subject for processing operations, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a DSGVO serves as the legal basis for the processing of personal data.
- (4) Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b DSGVO serves as the legal basis for the processing of personal data required for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party. This also applies to processing procedures that are necessary to carry out pre-contractual measures and to the transfer of personal data to third parties for the purpose of fulfilling the contract.
- (5) Insofar as the processing of personal data is required to fulfil a legal obligation to which the seller's company is subject, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. c DSGVO serves as the legal basis.
- (6) If we wish to use your data for advertising purposes for individual functions of our offer, we will inform you in detail about the respective processes.

The data will be stored for the duration of the business relationship and, in addition, as long as legal retention periods exist, legal claims can be asserted from the contractual relationship or other legitimate reasons justify further storage.

### §2 Your rights

- (1) You have the following rights towards us with regard to personal data concerning you:
  - Right to information,
  - Right to correction or deletion,
  - Right to limitation of processing,
  - Right of opposition to the processing,
  - Right to data transferability.

You also have the right to complain to a data protection supervisory authority about our processing of your personal data.

### §3 Collection of personal data when you visit our website

- (1) When using the website for information purposes only, i.e. if you do not register or otherwise provide us with information, we only collect the personal data that your browser transmits to our server. If you wish to view our website, we collect the following data, which are technically necessary for us to display our website to you and to guarantee stability and security (legal basis is Art. 6 Para. 1 S.1 lit. f DSGVO):
  - IP address
  - Date and time of the request
  - Time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
  - Content of the request (specific page)
  - Access Status/HTTP Status Code
  - the amount of data transferred in each case
  - Website from which the request comes
  - browser
  - Operating system and its interface
  - Language and version of the browser software
